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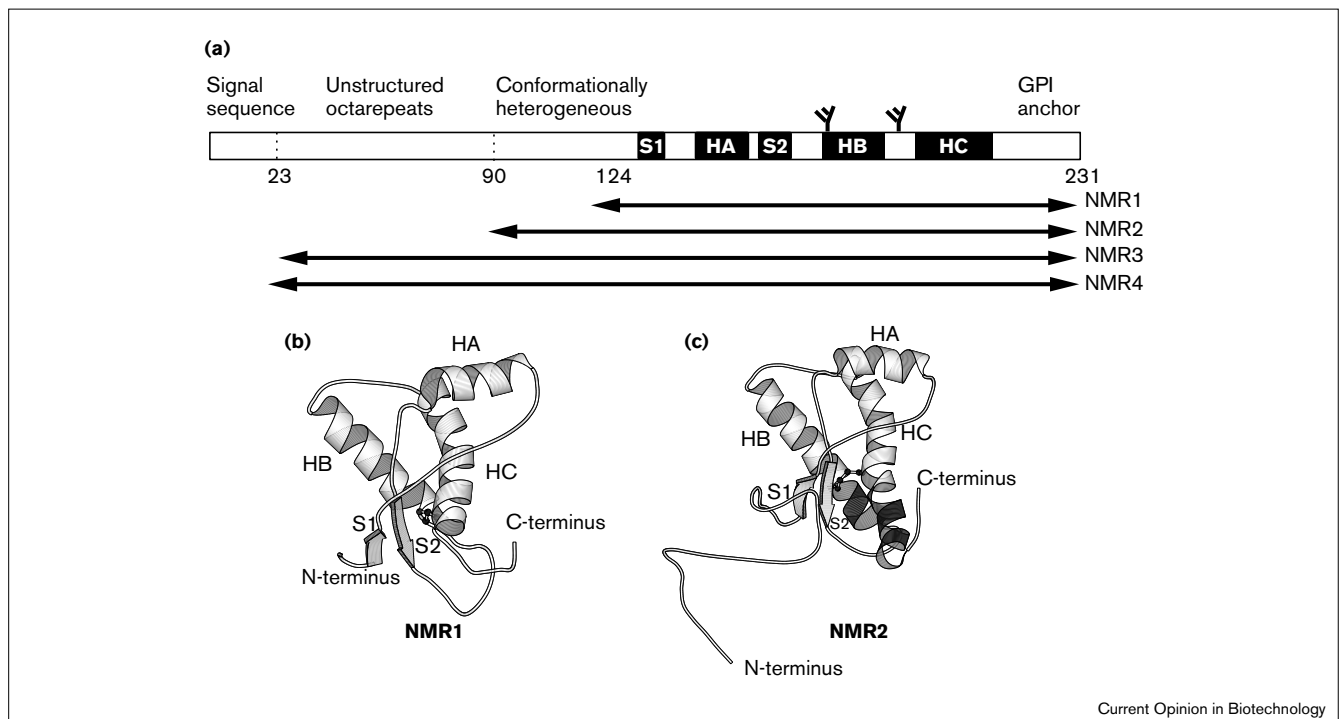

Structural features of PrP^C. **(a)** Secondary structure attributes of the prion protein are labeled along with the sequence. The branched symbols in helix B (HB) and the neighboring turn represent the N-linked glycosylation sites. The various fragments used for the NMR studies are indicated by the arrows: NMR1 [28], NMR2 [29], NMR3 [18], and NMR4 [20]. Ribbon traces of the NMR1 and NMR2 structures are given in (b) and (c), respectively. The dark portions of the helices in NMR2 correspond to extensions relative to NMR1. The molecular images were created using Molscript [57].
